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Working on a blanket, I found it difficult to keep track of progress on the squares and, after seeing how the marks and notes I made on my pattern made it difficult to read, decided that creating a spreadsheet would help organize the process.

Using an easy-to-follow format, each copy of the simple worksheet on the following page will keep you organized as you knit your way through 25 mitered squares. Print a few copies and set a goal of a square or two each week to keep yourself on track for a blanket worth of blocks.

The project pictured above and within this tutorial was made with Silk Garden; a wonderful yarn produced by Noro of Japan, taking advantage of the slow color changes within the yarn. Knitting the first section of a square with one end of the skein, then changing to the other end of the skein for the following section and switching back and forth following the directions, each skein yields two squares.
